

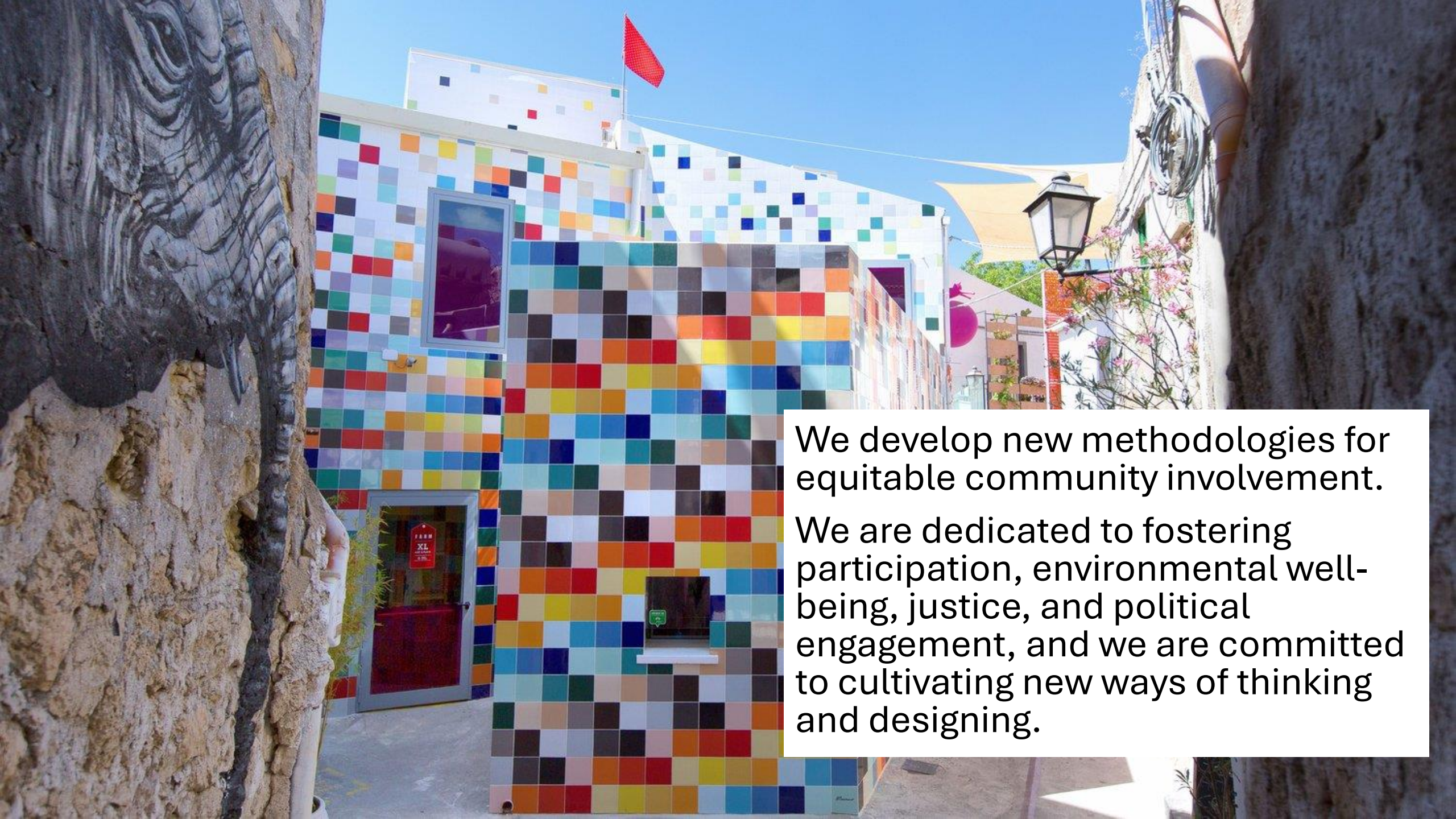
A transforming practice is a collective effort that humans and more-than-humans undertake to address societal challenges by changing their ways of living and working.
